Renewing Drivers License and your Fuel Tax Exemption

It has come to my attention that band members have been having problems with their "fuel tax exemption" when they have renewed their drivers license. I have contacted Service NS with the Fuel Tax Exemption Program and they had advised me of what has been happening. The reason some people have had a delay is because when you allow your drivers license to "EXPIRE" before you renew, it inactivates the "fuel tax exemption". Once the fuel tax has been inactivated Service NS is automatically notified electronically. They do not REACTIVATE your fuel tax exemption until the DMV has sent notification to Service NS that your drivers' license has been renewed. This process may take up to 3-5 business days and sometimes longer.

To AVOID your fuel tax exemption from being inactivated you can renew your drivers license before it expires. You may renew your drivers' license up to 2 months prior to the expiration date.
