The program "**Home Adaptations for seniors' Independence**" is a program based on age, property type and income levels. To be eligible for this program, you must meet all three of the following conditions:

1. The occupants are 65 years of age or older and have difficulty with daily activities due to loss of ability brought on by aging.
2. The home is a permanent residence
3. Total gross household income is at or below the program income limit for the area.

Home adaptations covered under the HASI program need to be permanent and make it easier and safer for a senior with a loss of ability to perform daily activities. Items such as handrails in the hallways and in stairways, easy to reach work and storage areas in the kitchen, lever handles on doors, walk in showers with grab bars, and bathtub grab bars and seats are examples of the types of adaptations that can be made under this initiative.

chuckle. So why you hangin with the likes of this," he says as he pushed me aside then continued to escort her to the waiting nurse leaving me to lag behind.

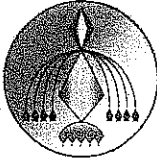


